#### Appalachia Outreach

To quote a miner in Appalachia after the last miners bodies were pulled from the mine: “Tomorrow, coal company shareholders still expect profits. Homeowners expect to be able to turn on their lights with electricity generated by coal. My family expects me to bring home a paycheck so they can buy groceries. We go (to work) with a heavy heart, but we have to go...”, he said.

Outside the courthouse in Harlan County, KY, stand two monuments, the first is for the dozens of young men who have given their lives in defense of our country over the past 200 years and the second, far larger one, contains hundreds of names of miners whose lives were lost. Only once, in 2001, has there been a year when no one was killed. Some years, like 1943, the list takes your breath away.

The people of Harlan proudly say that “the blood of their people dug the coal that melted the iron that forged the steel that built America”. They are a faith-filled people whose only source of income is to dig into the mountains and drag out the coal. As we read of the tragedies of the Appalachian coal mines, we can pray for their families and we can support our mission to them through our teenagers.

We hope to send 40 teens and 11 adults to Kentucky this year. They are working hard to earn their way. Please support the PANCAKE BREAKFAST on MAY 2ND, THE MOTHER'S DAY PLANT SALE on MAY 9TH, THE CAR WASH on MAY 22ND, take a SPONSOR PACKET from church and send in your check which will cover the cost of our food, transportation, and materials. As the sign said in the barber shop of Clear Fork: “God bless the coal miners and their grieving families”.
