# The Revised Roman Missal: Advent 2011

## Part VII: The **New** Nicene Creed

*I believe* in one God,  
The Father almighty,  
Maker of heaven and earth,  
Of all *things visible and invisible*.

*I believe* in one Lord Jesus Christ,  
The Only *Begotten* Son of the God, *born*  
of the Father *before all ages*.

God from God, Light from Light,  
True God from true God,  
Begotten not made,  
*Consubstantial with the Father*;  
Through Him all things were made.  
For us men and our salvation he came  
down from heaven, *and* by the Holy Spirit  
*was incarnate* of the Virgin Mary, and  
became man. For our sake he was  
crucified under Pontius Pilate, he *suffered*

*death* and was buried, *and rose again on*  
*the third day* in accordance with the  
Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and  
is seated at the right hand of the Father.  
He will come again in glory to judge the  
living and the dead and his kingdom will  
have no end.

*I believe* in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the  
giver of life, who proceeds from the  
Father and the Son, *who* with the Father  
and the Son *is adored* and glorified, who  
has spoken through the prophets.

*I believe* in one, holy, catholic and  
apostolic church. *I confess* one baptism  
for the forgiveness of sins *and I look*  
*forward* to the resurrection of the dead  
and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Following is an explanation of some of the significant changes to the Creed:

“I believe...”

The original Latin (“Credo”) translates into “I believe.” By using the singular instead of “We believe...” we make a *personal* commitment to the tenets of our faith, even though we recite the prayer in unison with fellow believers. This mirrors the renewal of our Baptismal vows at Easter, when we answer the priest’s questions (“Do you believe...?”) with “I do.” When we pray the new Creed in Advent, we will recall and strengthen what we accept and embrace, both personally and as a faith community.

“...consubstantial with the Father...”

Since Vatican II, we have used the description of the son as “one in Being with the Father. Although it conveys the same general idea as the new words, it is not a theologically precise as the term “consubstantial,” which translates literally to “the same substance” or equal to.” And precision was the goal of the council of Nicaea, at which time there was widespread heretical belief that the Father existed *before* the son. So while it may not be so easy to say, this new language helps preserve the work done by Church fathers when the Creed as we pray it was first proclaimed by the faithful.

“/...was incarnate of the Virgin Mary...”

In the new Creed, “Born of the Virgin Mary” will become “*incarnate* of the Virgin Mary.” Why the change? The word incarnate literally means “enfleshed.” The new wording is another important effort to be as accurate as possible in capturing the truths of our faith as expressed by those who formulated the Creed. Jesus was not just born of the Virgin Mary, but became man (“The Word became flesh” – Jn 1:14) by the power of the Holy Spirit at the *point of conception* in Mary’s womb.
